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DAY 1 FRIDAY 21ST JUNE 2019 VIC FALLS, ZIMBABWE
 Welcome to Africa, upon arrival we check into the Rainbow Hotel* for 4 nights.

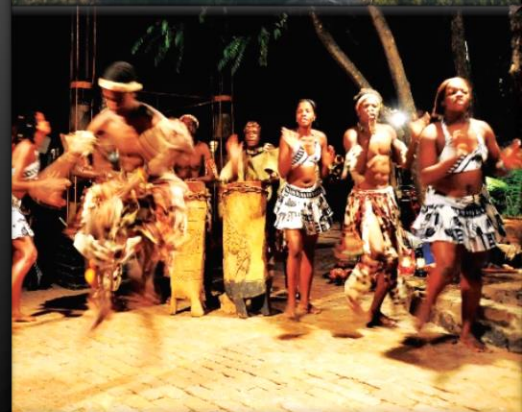
Victoria Falls presents a spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, forming the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It was described by the Kololo tribe living in the area in the 1800's as 'Mosi-oa-Tunya' – 'The Smoke that Thunders'. In more modern terms Victoria Falls is known as the greatest curtain of falling water in the world.

The Falls can be viewed from both Zimbabwe & Zambia, one special vantage point is across the Knife-edge Bridge, where visitors can have the finest view of the Eastern Cataract and the Main Falls as well as the Boiling Pot, where the river turns and heads down the Batoka Gorge. Other vantage points include the Falls Bridge, Devils Pool and the Lookout Tree, both of which command panoramic views across the Main Falls.

DAY 2 SATURDAY 22ND JUNE 2019 VIC FALLS, ZIMBABWE
 This morning after breakfast, you have an opportunity to visit Victoria Falls. Enjoy a scenic walk around one the Seven Wonders of the Natural World which is a mere ten minutes from the Hotel. National Park fee for entry to the Falls is **\$30USD** per visit. **This afternoon we head off on an included sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi River where we cruise for roughly 3 hours. Kasey performs in one of the most unique and amazing setting, drinks and nibbles included.**

DAY 3 SUNDAY 23RD JUNE 2019 VIC FALLS, ZIMBABWE
 Today is a day of leisure. An opportunity to take on some of the many activities Vic Falls has on offer. Lion walk, Elephant interaction & high tea, Rhino walking safari, Chobe National Park day trips, white water rafting & the famous bungee jump from Vic Falls bridge are just a sprinkler of what is on offer.

DAY 4 MONDAY 24TH JUNE 2019 VIC FALLS, ZIMBABWE
 Today is a day of leisure.
This evening we close out our stay in Victoria Falls with a show in a unique location that we like to keep secret. Dinner & drinks available at tonight's show.





DAY 5

TUESDAY 25TH JUNE 2019

NAIROBI, KENYA

Today we depart Victoria Falls and cross the border for our flight from Livingstone Airport, we fly north to mighty Kenya, upon arrival in Nairobi we are transferred to the Sarova Panafric* for our overnight stay as we prepare for departure to the Samburu tomorrow

DAY 6

WEDNESDAY 26TH JUNE 2019

MASAI MARA, KENYA

This morning we have an early departure from Nairobi as we head down into the great rift valley and on to the Masai Mara. Our travel time is roughly 6 hours. On arrival we settle into Ilkeliani luxury tented camp for a 4 night stay

DAY 7,8,9

THU 27TH, FRI 28TH & SAT 29TH JUNE 2019

MASAI MARA, KENYA

3 full days spent exploring the park in search of the big 5/other predators. Morning and afternoon game drives are offered. Optional hot air balloon safari can be arranged at an extra cost of US\$ 450 per person.

The Mara offers wildlife in such variety and abundance that it is difficult to believe: over 450 species of animals have been recorded here. You will hopefully see lions, rhinos, hippos, crocodiles, giraffe, wildebeests, zebras, buffalo, warthogs, hyenas, jackals, wild dogs, buffalo, leopard, many kinds of antelopes and elephant. It is in the Mara that perhaps the most spectacular event of the natural world takes place. This is the annual migration of millions of wildebeest and zebra from the Serengeti (Tanzania) in search of water and pasture. Following on their heels are the predators of the savanna- lion, cheetah, wild dog, jackal, hyena and vultures.

Kasey plays private shows for the group on days 7 & 9 at the lodge

DAY 10

SUNDAY 30TH JUNE 2019

NAIROBI, KENYA

This morning after breakfast we begin the trek back to Nairobi for our last night in Kenya, overnight at the Sarova Panafric OR SIMILAR



DAY 11 MONDAY 1ST JULY 2019

ZANZIBAR, TANZANIA

As we head to the airport we bid goodbye to Kenya and a beautiful hello to the stunning Island of Zanzibar. The island is famous for its mix of exotic beaches, famous spice plantations, history (Stone Town being the capital) and diverse culture. Zanzibar is also home to many endangered species including the red colobus monkey and green turtle.

The North and East Coast have particularly inviting beaches with powder white sand lapped by turquoise blue warm waters of the Indian Ocean and framed by many coconut and wild date palms. This makes for an ideal location to relax particularly after a safari. On arrival we check into Hakuna Majiwe Lodge or similar for our last 4 nights in Africa

DAY 12,13,14 TUE 2ND, WED 3RD, THU 4TH JULY 2019

ZANZIBAR, TANZANIA

3 full days at leisure to explore this beautiful island along with the amazing history it holds.

Kasey plays 2 final private group shows on days 12 & 14.

DAY 15 FRIDAY 5TH JULY 2018

END OF TOUR

Today marks the end of two amazing weeks in East Africa. We bid the group and your tour concludes with a transfer to your connecting flight home.
